- Leadership experience in clubs, teams, or volunteer initiatives.
- Fluency in more than one language (encompassing reading, writing, speaking, and listening abilities) to support our diverse community.
- Access to a car and a valid G2/G Ontario driver's license for Ontario staff or a valid Novice/Class 5 BC driver's license for Vancouver staff.
